At all courses, cadets will be given the opportunity to attempt the Multi Stage RAF Fitness Test to check their own level of fitness; cadets applying for the PEd course should have a good level of fitness, a natural aptitude for sports and preferably be in possession of the CSLA. Applications for courses should be submitted on the updated forms which can be found on BADER or requested from the undersigned.

4 I hope to include Av Tech courses in the very near future, plus additional Air Traffic Control, RAF Regiment and Aerospace Battle Manager Courses; Unfortunately for a variety of reasons I have been unable to secure courses for Movements Controller, Weapons Technician, Photographer and Information Systems Technician. Dates and eligibility requirements for any of these trade courses will be announced if they are confirmed. Applications will not be accepted for undated courses. I will continue to seek development and expansion of the programme and will update accordingly when situations change and courses are confirmed.
